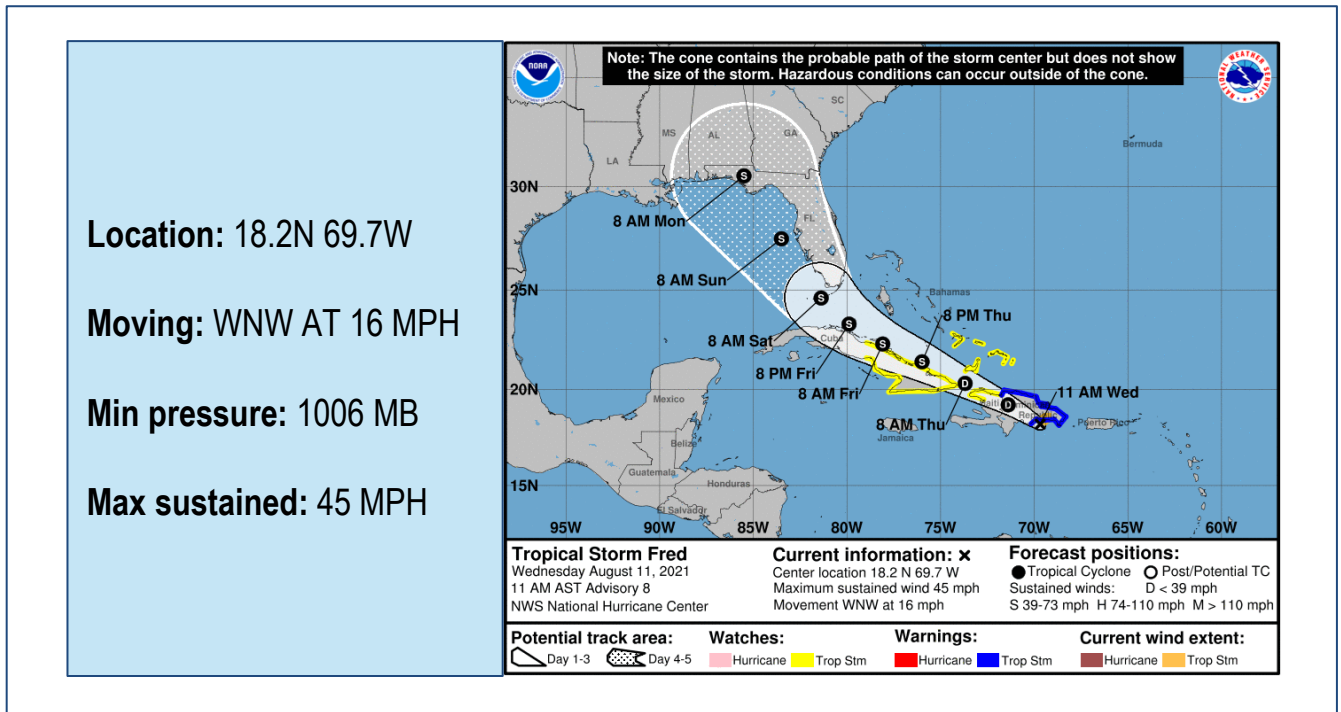


Tropical Storm Fred

TROPICAL STORM FRED MOVING TOWARDS HAITI, THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS AND THE BAHAMAS



National Hurricane Centre (NHC) Update

According to the National Hurricane Center (NHC) At 1100 AM AST (1500 UTC), the center of Tropical Storm Fred was located near latitude 18.2 North, longitude 69.7 West. Fred is moving toward the west-northwest near 16 mph (26 km/h), and a general west-northwestward motion with a decrease in forward speed is expected to continue for the next few days.

On the forecast track, the center of Fred is expected to be near or over Hispaniola this afternoon and evening, move near the Turks and Caicos Islands and the southeastern Bahamas on Thursday, and move near or north of the northern coast of central Cuba on Friday.

Maximum sustained winds are now near 45 mph (75 km/h) with higher gusts. Weakening is expected later today and tonight as the center of Fred crosses Hispaniola. Slow re-intensification is expected beginning Thursday night.

SUMMARY OF WATCHES AND WARNINGS IN EFFECT

A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect for

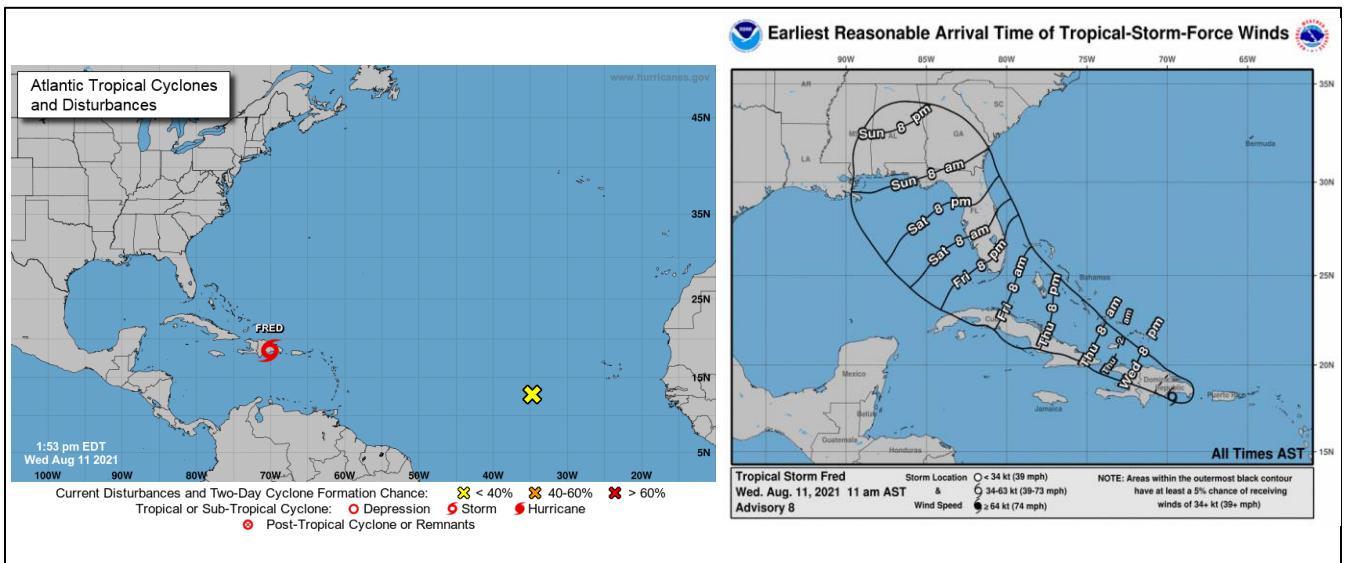
- Haiti (north coast from the Dominican Republic/Haiti border eastward)

A Tropical Storm Watch is in effect for

- Haiti (from the northern border with the Dominican Republic to Gonaives)
- Turks and Caicos Islands
- Southeastern Bahamas

A *Tropical Storm Warning* means that tropical storm conditions are expected somewhere within the warning area, in this case within the next 12 hours.

A *Tropical Storm Watch* means that tropical storm conditions are possible within the watch area.



CDEMA Actions and Updates from Participating States
